

What to Expect:

- Eyes will be swollen / mild puffiness for 2-3 days after.
- There may be some bruising or even a black eye.
- Your vision would be unaffected, but we strongly recommend that you don't drive home on the day of the procedure.
- You will be able to resume most normal daily activities the next day, but it's best to avoid swimming for 2 weeks while the wound heals.

Aftercare:

- Simply apply antibiotic ointment 4 times a day and otherwise leave alone.
- Any stitches (where used) would need to be removed at around 5-7 days later.
- Sometimes the wound is left to heal as a graze rather than using stitches, in which case there is no further appointment required.
- Eyelid skin heals very well and healing is normally complete in about 2 weeks.
- Apply saline soaked gauze cooled in the fridge 2-3 times a day for the first 1-2 days.
- Sleep with the head elevated.
- Clean the wound once daily with saline.
- Use eye drops as needed such as Optrex or Celluvisc to soothe.
